THE FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Merry Christmastide! Throughout the ages, Christians have celebrated Christmas as a season, including the twelve days between Christmas and the Epiphany as one long Christmas "day". The season of Christmas ends with our celebration of the Lord's baptism. The Baptism of the Lord falls on the Sunday after the solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. Today continues last Sunday's solemnity. The Baptism of the Lord is yet another powerful revelation (manifestation or epiphany) of Christ's identity: God's beloved Son, on whom his favor rests. Like the visit of the Magi and the wedding feast of Cana, the baptism of Christ by John in the River Jordan is an experience of God's action and presence revealed in Christ.

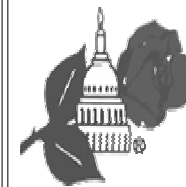
