THE SOLEMNITY OF SAINT JOSEPH is celebrated by the church on **Friday, March 19**. Today, we put aside our Lenten penance and celebrate this great solemnity. We sing the Gloria at mass and celebrate Joseph, the patron of the Universal Church. Tradition tells us that he had the great honor to have died in the presence of Our Lady and her Son, which fact makes him the patron of a holy death. Because during his life he was given the great responsibility of caring for and protecting the Virgin -- who is the Mother of all Israel -- and her Son, St. Joseph is considered the patron and protector of the entire Church. St. Joseph is a model of humility and holiness, and is a model for fathers everywhere. He cared for the Son of God, despite Jesus not being his own biological Son. His devotion to Mary, despite his suspicions of her infidelity, and his willingness to listen to the angel of God, demonstrate his humility. Our parish will celebrate mass at 8:00 AM and conclude the celebration with evening prayer at 7:00 PM.
