From the Pastor

I announced last weekend that there would be a minor change to the liturgy. The change which will begin this Sunday, June 13th, and also during weekday Masses is the following:

During the entrance procession, the congregation will face forward so that our attention and main focus is on the tabernacle and altar of sacrifice. The norm for this part of the Mass is for the people to face the front of the church. In the future there will be small changes which will help the flow of the liturgy, at which time I will seek to explain the reasoning behind them. If you have any questions please call me.

We will proceed with this improvement until all the stones are positioned properly. The two other cemeteries of St. Francis and Holy Trinity will also be addressed in a similar manner.

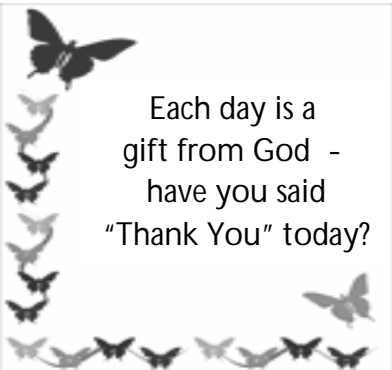

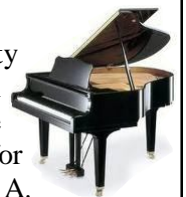
