The Church recommends that Catholics who have prepared themselves to receive Communion each time that they participate in the Mass. As Catholics, we believe that Christ is truly present under each of the species. The Eucharist always strengthens and unites the Church. CEMETERY FEES

There is revised inserts in today's bulletin that will clarify the cemetery fees that will take affect on August 1st. One of the questions that has been brought up is the grave opening. The fee listed on the previous bulletin insert was \$350 for grave opening. This expense covers the machine operator who receives \$300 to open and close the grave and the remaining \$50 will be paid to the cemetery for future care. There is also a charge of \$150 that the funeral home pays (which is not listed) to the cemetery from the charged expenses from families of the deceased which covers multiple costs and a stipend to the caregiver of the cemetery which will cover the following:

- lay out the grave
- fill with top soil
- reseed the grave

All local funeral homes will be receiving a letter reflecting these increases and will charge accordingly.

The revision reads as follows:

- Grave Opening-\$300.00
- Cemetery Fee -\$200.00
\$500.00

In total this will reflect an increase of only \$50.
