

Capital Improvements:

Your contributions to our parish help maintain our magnificent church building as well as the surrounding facilities, truly making it the center of prayer in our community. Within just the last year, we were able to take care of several projects in and around the church building/grounds. Most prominently, the St. Cecilia window in the choir loft was replaced after having been removed for repairs for over two years. The various leaks in the front façade of the church and in the towers, which were the cause of significant water damage, were also repaired. A new updated sign for the front of the church, with new mulch and lighting, was put in place, replacing the outdated marquee

which was over 20 years old. The storm drain culvert between the church and the school was recently replaced and the parking lot there was paved. The Marian garden which adorns the side of the church was also refurbished. The front of the school and parish office building were recently re-landscaped. The working parts of the air conditioning and furnace in the parish office building were replaced and lights along the sidewalk to the entrance were installed. In addition, a new bronze corpus was installed on the cross at Holy Trinity Cemetery. New speakers in the church were also installed providing a much louder, clearer sound for the worship space.
