CEMETERY RULES

Live or artificial flowers may be planted within one foot from the front edge of the memorial marker or grave stone and cannot be wider than the grave stone. No decorative items

- * whatsoever (including luminaries) are permitted <u>between</u> grave stones at any time. It is your responsibility to remove the adornments at the times set forth below. Adornments not removed at the times set forth below will be discarded.
- * United States flags and flag holders are permitted all year.
- Christmas decorations are permitted beginning the first Sunday in Advent. It is your responsibility to remove all Christmas decorations, including wreaths, by Ash Wednesday. Any adornments not removed by Ash Wednesday will be discarded.
- All adornments, except the US flag and marker, must be removed before Ash Wednesday, and * the cemetery must remain unadorned throughout Lent. Easter decorations are permitted from Palm Sunday through Pentecost.
- Only licensed vehicles allowed on cemetery roadways.
- * No pets are allowed in the cemetery.
- * All cemetery trash must be taken home for disposal or deposited in the garbage receptacle provided.

This cemetery is the property of the Partner Parishes. These rules are in place to keep order and beauty on the surface of the cemetery land and to pay respect to our loved ones who have died. Please be kind and respectful in this holy place.
