
Staying Connected During COVID-19

Please know that I have been keeping the parishioners of St. Lawrence Parish in my prayers during this pandemic. I can't even imagine the difficulties that you must be facing; balancing family, job, school and everything else that has been made more complicated by COVID-19. During this stress-filled time, I want you to know that our parish continues to care for the spiritual and material needs of our faith community.

Once our church building was closed in March, our faith community began to stream a weekend Mass at 5 p.m. on Saturdays. This virtual Mass continues even today. We have also provided updates via our website and Facebook page. As we came back to the church for worship, we created a Ministry of Hospitality to help welcome people back and assist them with the new expectations of in-person worship. We have also created volunteer cleaning crews to assist our custodial staff to sanitize the church and restrooms after each use.

Please know that as we all continue to journey through this pandemic, we will find ways to communicate and stay connected to each other. There were many positive responses to the in-home mailing that went out at Easter and gratitude for

the parish signing up with the FORMED on line platform so early in the shutdown.
